

FREE PROSTATE CANCER SCREENING

Sponsored by Mission Hospital Cancer Services

For all men who would like to be screened for prostate cancer, especially men who have a family history of prostate cancer, men who do not see a doctor on a regular basis, and men who do not have medical insurance.

Participants will have both a digital rectal exam and a PSA blood test done at this FREE screening.

You are eligible if:

- You are between the ages of 50 and 75.
(You can be screened as early as age 40 if you are African American or if you have a strong family history of prostate cancer.)
- You are NOT a patient of a urologist in Asheville.
- You have NOT had a prostate biopsy in the last year.
- You have NOT been diagnosed with prostate cancer.
